Forest school activities for September;

The children have settled well into Muddy Acorns, they enjoy giving Grand Mother Oak a hug and asking her questions. The children have received letters from the little people asking for their help, to build homes and a community for them within our forest school.

We have learnt the forest school rhyme “no pick, no lick, be careful with the stick”.

The children have learnt how to measure sticks with their arms and how to hold them safely.

We have learnt the fire pit rules and about how to move around the fire circle safely.

Since starting forest school, the children have built homes using natural materials, made chalk paints, hunted for bugs using magnifying glasses and bug pots and made jam on the fire.
